4 Matches followed by annual dinner on Saturday night.

Matches:

Match 1 - Rapid

300m Shoot - 2 sighters followed by 10 rounds Rapidfire to count in time of 50 seconds

Match 2 - Snap

300m Shoot - 10 rounds traditional military Double-tap Snap, 6 second target exposure

Match 3 - Deliberate

500m Shoot - 2 sighters optional with total 15 rounds to count in time limit of 12 minutes

Match 4 – Optical Deliberate

500m Shoot - 2 sighters followed by 10 rounds to count in time limit of 4 minutes
(Will be conducted if time permitting)

Qualifying Rifles:

Matches 1-3 are for Standard B Class rifle or Classic .303 Range Rifle
(military as-issued, any country of origin) or Classic .303 Range Rifle (Aperture sights)

Match 4 is only for F1, F2 or Tactical Rifles

F1 Class - As issued scoped military made up to 1946 (or faithful reproduction)

F2 Class - As issued scoped military made up to 1990 (or faithful reproduction)

Tactical Development - scoped special built tactical (not Benchrest)

The other section is for storage, bow range and .22 rifle indoor 25m range.

Accommodation Options:

A range of accommodation options are available for those who wish to arrive Friday, set up, practise and avoid an early drive down on Saturday

1. Local Motels , B& Bs, Caravan Parks
2. Park your caravan or put up your tent or swag on the large grassed area alongside the club house.
3. Set up your swag or camp stretcher in the main club house, storage area or under the verandah that runs the length of the building.

One can always find a spot away from others if they wish to sleep.

Food:

A cooked breakfast is available in the club house for those who don't wish to cook for themselves. Bacon, eggs, tomato, toast at a very reasonable price, plus tea and coffee.

Friday evening a BBQ dinner is available.

Saturday evening there is a dinner and presentation function so everyone can relax after a hard day on the range.

Soft drinks, beer and wine can be purchased from the bar or bring your own.

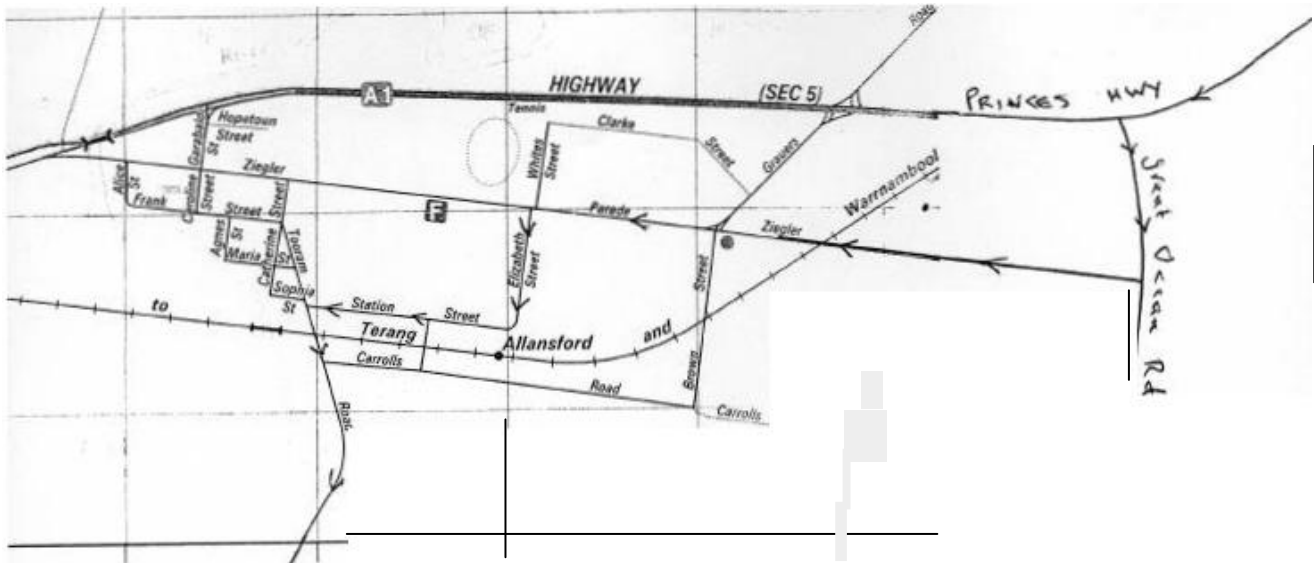
Wine and beer available after the range has closed for the day.

 Go past Brown Street
 Turn left into Elizabeth Street.
 Turn right into Station Street.
 At T junction, turn left into Tooran Road.
 Go past Hopkins Pt Road on right.
 Drive around a left bend in road.
 After 200m, turn right into Buckleys Road.
 Rifle Range on left, past motor cycle club
