MINIMUM STORAGE REQUIREMENTS FOR CATEGORY H

The handgun must be stored in a steel safe which:

- is of a thickness that is not easily penetrable;
- if it weighs less than 150 kilograms when empty, must be bolted to the structure of the premises; and
- is locked when any firearms are stored in it.

MINIMUM SAFE SPECIFICATIONS

A substitute safe with the following MINIMUM specifications:-

- (i) Not less than 5mm mild steel plate, welded construction suitably reinforced.
- (ii) Not readily portable – it may be adequately secured to a structure or object which is not readily portable.
- (iii) The security of the safe shall not be dependent on external hinges or lock(s).
