300m Deliberate. 10 rounds prone in 6 minutes. (CSD Match 10)
200m Snap B. 10 round kneeling. 10 rounds in 3 sec per shot. (CSD Match 7)
100m Rapid fire B. 1 phase of 2x5 rounds in 50 sec. (CSD modified Match 4)



February 4th SWISS & SWEDISH RIFLES Competition

Rifle: CLASS B Rifles issued to Swiss & Swedish forces
Schmidt Ruben, M93 Mannlicher, etc
Swedish Mauser M96, M38, M40, etc.



Range: 100m
Format: 10 rounds standing in 2 minutes

March 3rd GALLIPOLI (Bayonet Shoot)

Rifle: Any CLASS B Rifle – with appropriate bayonet fixed



Range: 100m
Format: 10 rounds sitting or kneeling in 2 minutes.

May 12th MARTINI HENRY and Single Shot Black Powder Rifles & IOC

Rifle: Martini Henry or other single shot black powder military rifle. (Black powder ammunition)
Snider, Springfield, Sharps, etc.



Range: 100m
Format: 10 rounds Prone in 2 minutes.
&
IOC Rapid fire A, 100m, unlimited shots, 15 sec. (CSD Match 3)

June 2nd BARBAROSSA (WWII) Competition

Rifle: Any Class B 8mm Mauser Rifle vs Class B Rifles issued to Russian forces, Mosin Nagant, etc.



Range: 100m
Format: 5 rounds prone, 5 rounds standing, in 2 minutes.

July 7th MAD MILITIA RIFLES

Rifle: CLASS B Rifles not in other specialty shoots.
Range: 100m
Format: 10 rounds standing in 2 minutes

August 4th LONG TAN (Vietnam War) Falling Plate Team Event

Rifle: Any CLASS B rifle



Range: 200m
Format: Steel plates, Timed team event with 5 plates per team. Teams of four shooters.

September 1st CARBINE COMPETITION

Rifle: CLASS A - Close Range Carbine Type Rifles
Short barrel (Approx 540mm/21 inches)



Range: 100m
Format: Phase 1: Competitors fire 5 rounds in 30 seconds from the 'Standing Unsupported' position. The action must be open, chamber empty, with butt of rifle visible below the elbow at waist height prior to the command 'Fire'.
Phase 2: Repeat Phase 1. (CSD Match 11)

October 6th 2ND ALAMEIN (WWII) RIFLES

Rifle: Rifles issued to Italian forces Vetterli, Mannlicher, Carcano, etc. vs British 0.303 Class B Rifles issued to Commonwealth forces.
